The ideal candidate will have a full driving licence with previous experience of driving a minibus or a larger vehicle. A D1 licence is required for this role, a PCV licence would be preferred.

As well as having solid driving experience and know-how of driving larger vehicles, you will be supporting residents to get out of their homes, reconnect with the local community, and access stimulating activities that reflect their passions and personalities and reignite their love for life. A reasonable level of fitness is required for this post. This job can be physically demanding in terms of regular driving and manoeuvring wheelchairs to and from the vehicle and securing them once they are in the vehicle.
